### **Obituary**

Veldon Robinson, affectionately known as "Fat Daddy" was born on August 3, 1929, in Warren, North Carolina to the late Willie & Feby Robinson. On Wednesday, December 21, 2022, at his home in Glenarden, MD, God called him home for eternal rest. Weldon received Christ at an early age and was baptized. His family moved to Suffolk, Virginia after the loss of his father. Weldon relocated to Maryland for employment. He left home with only his luggage of clothing. He was employed by the District of Columbia Environmental Services (Washington Sanitation Commission) and worked for 38 years until he retired February 27, 1990.

Weldon joined the Sylvan Vista Baptist Church and was given the Right Hand of Fellowship after the loss of his wife, Josephine Robinson in 1997. He was a faithful, active and supporting member of his Church. He sang in the Male Chorus and Mass Choir, faithfully attending Sunday School and Bible Class. For many years he maintained the landscaping of the Church and the lot across the street until his health prevented him from continuing. Weldon was happy to help, using his own lawn equipment and gas, helping in any way and never complained. He would make sure the water coolers were filled, maintained the toiletries in the restrooms and even helped clean after special services and events. Weldon never felt that any work around the Church or his home was beneath him.

In 2005, he married his beloved wife and friend, Mable Robinson. As husband and wife, they lived their lives striving to be the best example of a godly marriage. You would often find them watching and enjoying western movies together. Weldon enjoyed landscaping and sports. He loved his family and community. He would help others with cutting grass, trimming and edging their yards. He worked landscaping and unloaded freight trucks at warehouses for many years. He worked part time between his split shifts at the Sanitation Commission.

Weldon was a very active motorcycle rider in the club he joined in the 1950's. He was a member of the DC Saddle Squad and participated in many events. He traveled to many cities and states. Weldon was a diehard Washington Commanders aka Washington Redskins fan; win or lose they were his team. He loved football, basketball, baseball, and softball, it didn't matter whether it was the men's, women's or a little league team playing, he loved to watch sports. He even had the opportunity to coach the women's softball team in the City of Glenarden, MD. Weldon enjoyed spending much of his free time with his friends at the Pancake House, with the McDonalds in Kentland Crew and the 7-11 Crew in Glenarden. His smile would light the room. He was kind, loving, and giving, and he never met a stranger. That's just the type of person Fat Daddy was.

He was preceded in death by four sisters: Martha Ann Alston, Lula Mae Davis, Lucy Bell Alston, and Helen Robinson, three brothers: Arthur Alston, John Robinson and Walker King Robinson; one daughter Linda M. Wallace; one son John Weldon Robinson.

He leaves to cherish his memory his Wife Mable Robinson, two sons Clyde Eugene Robinson and Jerome Warren Robinson; stepchildren: Tyrone Queen (Linda), Sherraine Houston (Henry), Belinda Queen (Tracey), Monica Fields (Cornell), Jerome Queen (Mia); his brother Harvey Robinson (Rosa) of Franklinton, North Carolina and a host of grandchildren, great-grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews, other relatives, and friends.


